In November 2019, while walking the halls at IMM praying, I had no idea that healing was the road the Holy Spirit was leading me down. I only sensed God leading me to return to coaching. I use return very loosely, as I had only had one class and never truly coached, but it was something with which I was familiar, and it interested me. Now, the Holy Spirit was igniting a passion.



Where that Holy Spirit moment would lead, I had no idea, but the Holy Spirit knew what I had been dealing with physically, mentally, and emotionally, and He knew what the future held. He was aware that I had been dealing with migraines for 8 years with little relief, He understood the transition from Russia, which I had yet to process, and He knew a pandemic would literally make the world stand still in just a few short months. He foresaw that the lock down and restrictions on life and ministry would lead to me seeking healing and direction, and that I would have the time to focus on the process. I didn't know it then, but my life was about to change completely, and healing was on its way.

The process of receiving my International Coaching Federation and AG Coaching credentials required that I have 100 logged coaching hours, with many of those hours being bartered with others pursuing certification. Through the bartering process my mind was gradually set free from things that had held me hostage for some time. My emotions were released, so that I could not only love others more, but also learn to love myself again. Little did I know, but I was also receiving healing from the migraines that had limited my life for so long.

Receiving my credentials took over two years, but it brought deep healing. That road of healing has now positioned me where I'm able to help others using coaching, as well as my DISC assessment certification, which I also received this year. The Holy Spirit has opened my eyes to how the two complement each other. Coaching and DISC can be used to help teams, individuals, and families not just communicate better, but also be more effective in their labors for the kingdom.

Healing is not always instantaneous; it is more often a process that takes time. Would I have guessed that a Holy Spirit moment in November 2019 would lead to healing, not just for myself, but for others as well? Absolutely not! What I couldn't see then, I see clearly now as another step in our God-sized dream.
